VERSE 1

We've been talkin' bout Jackson, ever since the fire went out,

I'm goin' to Jackson, I'm gonna mess around (men)

G7

C

Yeah I'm goin' to Jackson, look out Jackson town.

VERSE 2

C

Well go on down to Jackson, go ahead and wreck your health (women)

C

C7

Go play your hand, you big talkin' man, make a big fool of yourself

F

C

Yeah, go to Jackson, go comb your hair!

F

I'm gonna snowball Jackson (men)

G7 C

See if I care! (women)

VERSE 3

C

When I breeze into that city, people gonna stoop and bow (men) Ha!! (women)

All them women gonna make me, teach 'em what they don't know how (men)

F

C

I'm goin' to Jackson, you turn and loosen my coat

F

Honey I'm goin' to Jackson

G7

"Good bye!" That's all she wrote (women)

VERSE 4

Heck, they'll laugh at you in Jackson, and I'll be dancing on a pony keg (women)
