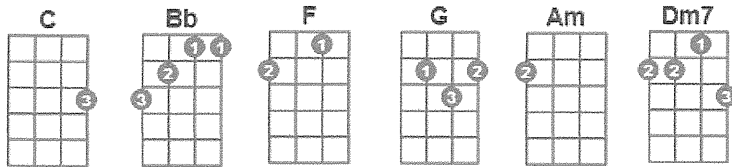


If You Could Read My Mind

Intro: Strum [C] 4 bars

[C] If you could read my mind love, [Bb] what a tale my thoughts could tell
[C] Just like an old time movie, [Bb] about a ghost from a wishing well
[C] In a castle dark or a [F] fortress strong
With [G] chains upon my [Am] feet - you [F] know that ghost is [C] me
And [F] I will never [C] be set free
As [Dm7] long as I'm a [G] ghost that you can't [C] see

[C] If I could read your mind love, [Bb] what a tale your thoughts could tell
[C] Just like a paperback novel, the [Bb] kind that drugstores sell
[C] When you reach the part [F] where the heartaches come
The [G] hero would be [Am] me but [F] heroes often [C] fail
And [F] you won't read that [C] book again
[Dm7] because the ending's [G] just too hard to [C] take

who gets [G] burned in a three way [Am] script
