INTRO: C, Dm, G7, C, C, Dm, G7, (First 2 lines)

*Tacit* C Dm G7 C  
*Verses* Think I'll go out to Al - berta weather's good there in the fall  
 Dm G7 G7  
 I've got some friends that I could go to working for  
 C Dm G7 C  
 Still I wish you'd change your mind, if I ask you one more time  
 Dm F G7 G7  
 But we've been through this a hundred times or more

CHORUS: C Dm G7 C  
 Four strong winds that blow lonely, seven seas that run high  
 Dm G7  
 All those things that don't change come what may  
 C Dm G7 C  
 If the good times are all gone, then I'm bound for moving on.  
 Dm F G7 G7  
 I'll look for you if I'm ever back this way

G7 C/  
 (LAST CHORUS - REPEAT LAST LINE FADING - then) .... four strong winds

C Dm G7 C  
*Verses 2* If I get there before the snow flies, and if things are looking good.  
 Dm G7 G7  
 You could meet me if I sent you down the fare  
 C Dm G7 C  
 But by then it would be winter, not too much for you to do.  
 Dm F G7 G7  
 And those winds sure can blow cold way out there

CHORUS (softly)

INSTRUMENTAL over first 2 lines of verse - C, Dm, G7, C, C, Dm, G7, G7

C Dm G7 C  
 Still I wish you'd change your mind, If I ask you one more time.  
 Dm F G7 G7  
 But we've been through that a hundred times or more
